

DIALOG--EPISODE ONE
INT. TEMPLE
SCENE 21.

DRAKE I'm sick of mucking around in this temple looking for buried treasure that doesn't exist. We were cleaning up in the Ivory racket until you got this fool notion in your head.

MACKLIN Who says it's a fool notion?
